

Health and Safety Guidelines for the 2020-2021 School Year

These policies are based on what is currently known about the transmission and severity of COVID-19 and is updated as needed and as additional information becomes available.

What your Child May Bring to School

- Labeled book bag (provided for you) and sippy cup (2's only)
- Labeled lunch box (containers within lunch box also need to be labeled)
- Children are welcome to wear a mask, but not required. Teachers will do their best to help encourage them to wear it throughout the day.

Children may not bring toys, "lovies", blankets or stuffed animals from home (There may be special event days where your child can bring items from home to school. This will be listed on your child's monthly calendar.)

Arrival to Preschool

- Parents will drop off children through morning carpool line
- Children's temperatures will be checked before leaving their vehicle
- Limits on individuals entering the building
- Teachers will wash hands once children arrive in their classrooms
- School bags and lunch boxes may be sanitized after arriving in the classroom

The Preschool Day

- Proper hand washing will continue throughout the preschool day
- Classrooms will have Chapel and recess; times will be staggered for cleaning each area. Teachers and children will stay with their individual classroom
- Supplies will be cleaned after an activity
- Toys and/or manipulatives used during the day will be placed outside the classroom to be cleaned. Depending on the material that makes up the toy or manipulatives used items will be washed in the washing machine or spraying and hand cleaning the toy daily
- High touch areas will be cleaned throughout the day
- Rooms will be cleaned every afternoon with an electrostatic sprayer
